"Keep on the Sunny Side" was originally written in 1899, but the song was popularized by The Carter Family's version, recorded and released in 1928. When the Carters became a regular act on Border Radio, broadcast from Mexico in the 1930s, "Keep on the Sunny Side" became their signature song, which often opened their radio shows.
